

Behavior Agreement

Welcome to our summer camp program. We have many things planned for the summer campers and look forward to a wonderful experience here at MDCCC.

In order for everyone to enjoy the camp, we must have an understanding of what is expected for each person. We are asking every parent to go over the following list of behaviors and disciplines with his/her child and sign it.

Your support will be greatly appreciated to make this our best camp ever. Thank you.

1. Respect authority. Children will not talk back with loud, rude language to an adult or each other. When a child needs correction, it will be done immediately in a constructive, positive, redirecting manner.
2. Respect everyone's safety. Children will not endanger the safety of self or others. If a child hits, bites, or otherwise knowingly inflicts harm upon another child, his/her parent will be notified to pick up his/her child immediately. It will be decided by the lead teacher and parents when the child may return to camp.
3. Respect everyone's feelings. No verbal abuse or threats will be tolerated. If a child uses words that are belittling, emotionally injuring or threatening to another person, the parents will be notified and a meeting will be required within 24 hours.
4. Respect property. If a child knowingly damages or mishandles property that does not belong to her/him, the parents will be notified and a meeting may be required depending on the severity or repetition of the behavior. It will be up to the center's director to decide if restitution is needed.
