General Information Hours: 9AM-5PM (campers) 3/26/21

<u>Field Trips</u> - Your activity fee covers <u>most</u> field trips. If more funds are needed, you will be notified. Make sure your child is here by the time posted on the calendar. This is the time we will leave.

<u>Calendar</u> - The calendar may be subject to change. If there is questionable weather during outdoor trips or transportation complications, we will have an alternate activity ready at the child care center.

<u>Day Closed</u> - Summer Camp will be closed on July 2 for the holiday.

<u>Tuition</u> - All tuition is due on Mondays, 5PM for each week. Add \$20 late fee if after this time. If after 1 week of no payment, care will be suspended until all fees are paid.

<u>Swim Days</u> - This summer we will be swimming often. The center will provide sunscreen 50SPF and insect repellent. Make sure your child's swim wear and all accompanying items are marked with their name and sent in a bag. All swimsuits and towels will be sent home on Fridays to be washed. Don't forget to bring them back.

<u>Clothes</u> - It is a state regulation that each child needs to have an extra set of clothes at the center at all times. This includes a shirt, pants or shorts, socks and underwear. You can bring them in a bag and they will be kept in your child's box for the duration of the summer.

Quiet Time - State regulations require a rest period for children that are in the child care center for more than 6 hours a day. The children will have a choice of three different areas. Movie area - These movies must be rated G in order to be shown. Reading area - This area will have books to read. Children may also bring books from home. Puzzle/Drawing area - We will have materials available. There are some days when electronics will be allowed.

<u>Electronics</u> - Games brought to the center come at their own risk. Children will not be made to share. The center will not be responsible for any lost or broken electronics or games. Any problems caused by electronics will result in the teacher taking them away and returning them to parents at the end of the day, or doing away with the privilege entirely.

<u>Safety Notice</u> - Do not send your child to camp in flip-flops or slip-on sandals. This is a hazard when running or playing on the playground equipment. Children must wear tennis shoes or sandals with straps to hold them on their feet. The kids can bring flip flops on swim days to wear.
